**Freedom of Mobility Foundation Grants Washington D.C. Center for Independent Living  
\$10,000 for Travel Training Initiatives**

**FAIRFIELD, Calif., (March 30, 2011)** - Freedom of Mobility Foundation, Inc. (FMFI), the charitable branch of United States-based transportation contracting firm and paratransit service provider, MV Transportation, Inc., selected Washington D.C.'s Center for Independent to receive a \$10,000 Travel Training Grant.

This is the third travel training grant given this year by Freedom of Mobility Foundation, the other recipients were centers for independent living in South Florida and Chicago. In total, FMFI has granted \$25,000 specifically for travel training in 2011.

D.C. Center for Independent Living will use the grant to enhance current programs providing travel training to people with disabilities, teaching them the skills required to travel safely on fixed-route public transportation.

"Freedom of Mobility Foundation was created to address needs just like this one. It is our goal to help people with disabilities safely use public transportation and in turn give them greater independence," said Quisa Foster, project manager for Freedom of Mobility Foundation.
